Better Mileage Driving Tips

- Travelling light will save you more fuel. Leave your golf bags, bicycle racks, spare containers of oil etc. at home if you do not require them. The more weight you carry around in the car, the higher your fuel consumption.
- Higher octane does not translate into more power for your car. Follow the fuel type recommendations from the car manufacturer.
- Spark plugs should be serviced or replaced at least once a year or every 20,000km travelled. This will ensure an easy start up and optimum combustion.
- Switch off the engine if you are waiting for more than 5 minutes. Leaving your car to idle not only uses up more fuel, it will also increase the wear and tear on the engine.
- Brake fluid should be replaced every 2 years, this will ensure proper braking efficiency.
- Have the anti-freeze (coolant) in your car replaced every 12 months. This will keep your engine running cool. The anti-freeze will also prevent corrosion in the cooling system and lubricate the water pump at the same time.
